Privacy policy and the use of cookies

Our Privacy Policy and Cookies are described below.

Introduction

These Terms of Use constitute the terms and conditions of use of this website www.dionysiatrust.com (hereinafter referred to as the "Website"), which is offered for use whoever interested (hereinafter referred to as "Users") by "Dionysia Astiki Etaireia – AMKE" (hereinafter referred to as "DIONYSIA TRUST").

All references to "ours", "us", "we" within this policy and within the warning notice are considered to refer to DIONYSIA TRUST.

DIONYSIA TRUST is committed to preserving the privacy of all visitors to the website www.dionysiatrust.com and to protect any personal data you provide us.

We provide this Privacy Policy and the use of Cookies to help you understand what we do with the personal data we receive / obtain from you. By providing your personal data, you declare that you accept the Privacy Policy and the use of Cookies and agree to collect, use and disclose your personal information as described herein. If you do not agree with this Statement of Duty, please do not give us your personal information.

What are personal data?

Personal data is information about an identifiable person as defined by the applicable law, such as name, email address and telephone number.

Personal data we collect from you and the use of personal data collected

In general, you can visit the site without telling us who you are or disclosing any information about yourself. Our servers collect IP addresses for information technology (IT) purposes, making it easy for you to connect to our platform and provide you with our services, not emails of the visitors.

We may also collect your personal data, such as your name and email address, with your consent whenever you email us your information. You will find that it is not mandatory to provide us with additional information we ask for, which is not necessary or reasonable to provide you with the services you have requested.

For all data processing you consent to, you may refuse or withdraw your consent at any time without any detrimental effect on any contact you may have with us.

Policy for the use of Cookies

This site uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our site. This helps us to offer you a good experience when browsing our site and also allows us to improve our website.

A cookie is a small file of numbers and letters that we store on your browser or on your computer's hard drive. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

1. Necessary Cookies

They are the least necessary cookies where they are important for the proper operation of the site. These Cookies are the ones that allow you to browse and use site features such as access to secure sites. These cookies work independently of your individual identity and are responsible for the smooth operation of the site.

`_cfduid`: Used as a device user ID to apply security settings. It does not contain user identification information

B. Statistics Cookies

These are the cookies that explain the visitor's behavior regarding on how they use the site (e.g., which pages they visit most often). These are cookies that are used only strictly for statistical purposes, so that after technical actions the performance of a website can be improved.

`_utm.gif`: Used by Google analytics to verify the user's browser and its computer.

`_utma`: Used to define new visitors as well as those who have returned to the site.

`_utmb`: Used to identify a new session. Its ending time is 30 minutes, so if a user is inactive for a longer time than this, a new cookie will be set and this interaction will be recorded as a new session.

`_utmc`: Works in conjunction with cookie `utmb` and defines new visitors.

`_utmt`: Sets the throttle request rate.

`_utmz`: Used to identify the traffic source. Its expiry date is after 6 months. This helps Google collect the data, which can then help you determine the traffic in the Analytics Multi-Channel section.

1. Marketing Cookies

Targeting and advertising cookies collect information about user actions on the site. The direct result is the collection of information such as the number of visitors, the number

of pages viewed, etc., so that the services provided to you, according to your preferences, can be constantly improved.

GPS: Used by youtube and contains a unique mobile code to allow tracking based on the user's location.

VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE: Used by youtube to verify the user's speed on pages that have built-in youtube videos.

YSC: Used by youtube and contains a unique code to keep statistics about which videos the user has seen.

1. Performance Cookies

These Cookies collect information so we can improve the website.

_utma tracks user visits and time of first, previous, and current visit

_utmb Used to track how long you stay on a web page – when a visit starts and when it approximately ends

¬_utmz Used to track how long you stay on a website – when a visit begins and when it's about to end. It is short term.

_utmz The traces from which a visitor comes (search engine, search keyword, link)

1. Functionality Cookies

These cookies help us personalize our content for you, invite you with your name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of a certain language or region). If you choose to delete / deactivate functionality cookies, any preferences / settings you have selected will not be retained for your subsequent visits to the Website.

PHPSESSID maintains visiting information

_ga Keeps statistics on the use of the site

_gat _gid collect Use from Google Analytics

How do I disable / enable cookies?

You have the ability to accept or reject cookies by modifying the settings in your browser. However, you may not be able to use all the interactive features of our site if cookies are disabled.

There are several ways to manage cookies. See your browser's instructions or the help screen to learn more about these features. For example, in Internet Explorer, you can go to Tools / Internet Options / Security & Privacy to adjust your browser to your expectations. If you use different computers in different locations, you need to make sure that each browser is customized to suit your cookie preferences.

The personal data you provide to us will be transferred to a Data Center hosted in Greece by the company GoDaddy and can be accessed or given to our staff working in Greece and to third parties in the business partners, government agencies and law enforcement agencies, who are committed to processing data on our behalf, some of which may be outside the European Economic Area and are acting for us purposes and reasons set out in this policy.
